Long Beach Transit Service Changes Effective August 30

Several Routes Will Experience Minor Schedule Adjustments

LONG BEACH, CALIF. (August 28, 2009) – Starting Sunday, August 30, schedule changes will commence on routes 81, 91, 92, 93, 96, 101, 102, 103, 111, 112, 171, 172, 173, 174, 181, 182, 191, 192, 193 and Passport A, D, & C.

Route 81 will have mid-day service frequency changed from every 30 minutes to every 40-45 minutes.

Routes 91, 92, 93 & 94 will have early morning service added on weekdays and weekends. Routes 91 and 94 will operate more frequently on weekends.

Routes 101, 102, & 103 will experience weekday schedule adjustments, including new running times, a layover adjustment on Santa Fe Avenue and the elimination of the first East and West Saturday trips.

Routes 111 & 112 will have new running times and weekday peak hour service frequency changed from every 10-13 minutes to every 15 minutes.

Route 171 will have increased frequency of service from every 30 minutes to every 25 minutes.

Routes 172, 173 & 174 will experience minor weekday schedule adjustments and more frequent service on the weekends.

Routes 181 & 182 will have early morning and late night weekend service changed from every 30 minutes to every 40-60 minutes.

Routes 191, 192 & 193 will have minor weekend schedule adjustments. Route 191 will have more frequent weekday and weekend evening service from Del Amo & Cherry to downtown Long Beach.

Passport A & D frequency will be increased from every 15 minutes to every 12 minutes.

Passport C will have Friday and Saturday night service will be modified to operate every 20 minutes after 10PM.
